Singapore, 11 January 2024 – Wilmar International (Wilmar) announced that its No Deforestation and No People Exploitation (NDPE) Sugar has been recognised to be Gold Level Equivalent in the <u>Farm Sustainability Assessment (FSA) 3.0</u> by the Sustainable Agriculture Initiative Platform (SAI Platform). This comes on the heels of the <u>announcement</u> in November 2023 that Wilmar's NDPE Sugar was aligned to the Gold Level for FSA 3.0.

This significant milestone further demonstrates Wilmar's commitment to develop and implement a comprehensive and effective sustainability commitment that encompasses environmental responsibility, social empowerment and ethical production and sourcing in the sugar sector.
